Commissioner Announces Hearing Details for Greer Solar Project in Washington County

GREENVILLE, MS (June 21, 2024)— Central District Mississippi Public Service Commissioner De'Keither Stamps will hold a hearing on Thursday, June 27 to consider the petition of Greer Solar, LLC, to construct, own, and operate a solar electric generating and storage facility in Washington County.

The hearing will take place at the Washington County Courthouse (900 Washington Avenue, Greenville) in the Supervisor's Meeting Room and will begin at 5:00 p.m. Commissioner Stamps invites all interested parties to attend and provide comments on the proposed project.

Greer Solar, LLC, is proposing to build a 170-megawatt solar facility on approximately 1,000 acres in Washington County. During the hearing, Commissioner Stamps will consider various aspects of the project, including its potential environmental impact, land use, and economic benefits. The Commission will also hear from representatives of Greer Solar, local residents, and other stakeholders.
